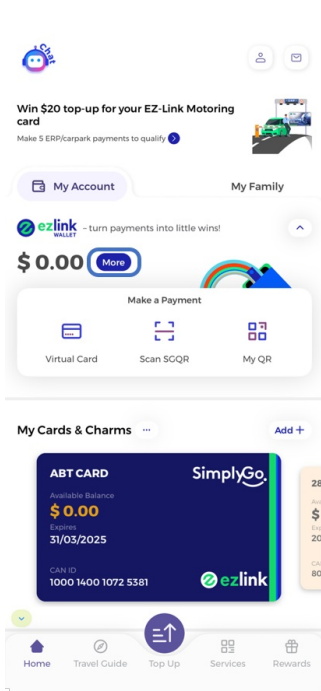

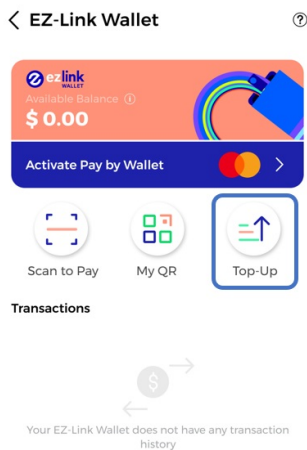
## Topping up EZ-Link Wallet

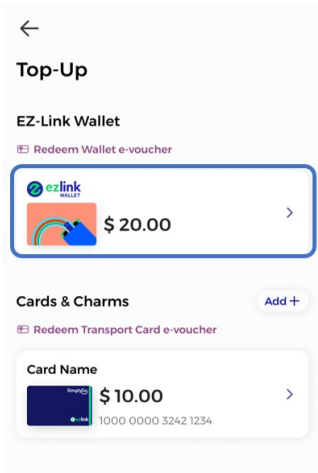
### Step 1: Tap "More"



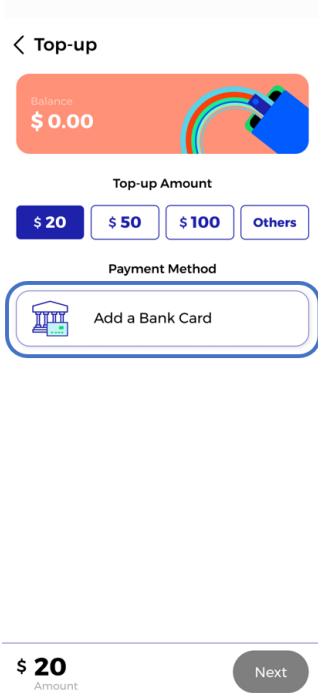
### Step 2: Tap "Top-Up"
